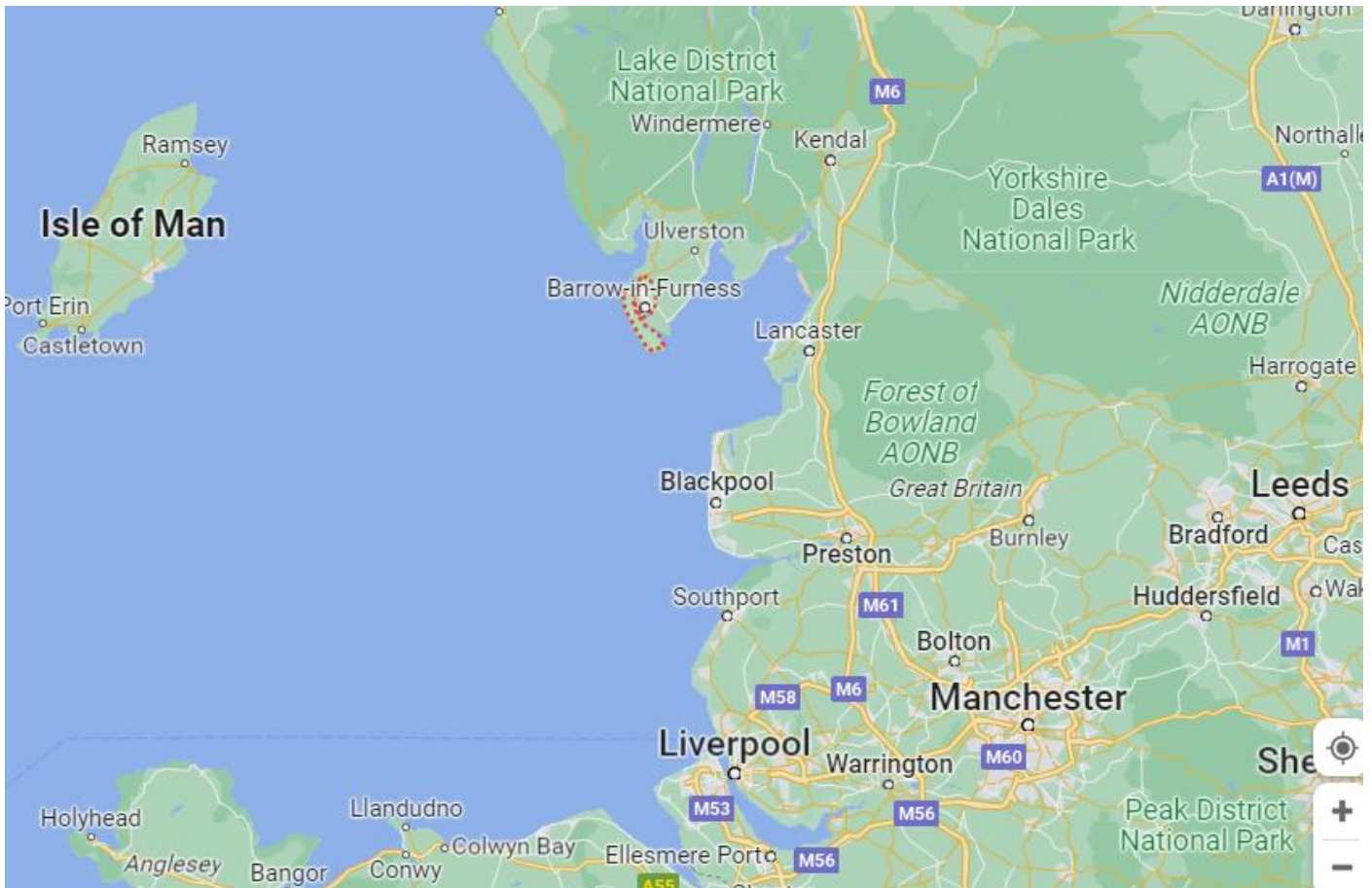
FOREWORDS

Note: The name changed from Corkill to Corkhill towards the end of the 1800s for this family, as we know it in this journal. The historic meaning and spelling are explained in the following script which can be found online at...

This interesting and unusual surname is of Manx origin, and is a contraction of the Gaelic "MacThorketill, MacThorkill". The Gaelic name is composed of "Mac", son of, and the Old Norse personal name "Thorketill" and "Thorkell". The given name is recorded in the Domesday Book of 1086 as "Turketel" (Norfolk and Suffolk), and "Turkil" (Suffolk), and derives from the Old Norse "Thor", the name of the God of Thunder in Scandinavian mythology, and "ketill", (sacrificial) cauldron. The name "Thurkill" and "Thirkill" was in use throughout England in the Middle Ages; in northern England it had been introduced directly by Scandinavian settlers, whereas in the south it was the result of Norman influence. Corkill is first recorded in the Isle of Man in 1505. In the modern idiom the surname can be found as Corkhill and Corkill. Recordings of the surname from the Isle of Man Church Registers include: the christening of John, son of Thomas Corkill, which took place at Braddan on June 20th, 1647; the christening of Ewan, son of Dond Corkill, which took place on December 26th, 1648, at Maughold; and the marriage of Donald Corkill and Issabell Colteam, which took place at Maughold, on June 12th 1652. The first recorded spelling of the family name is shown to be that of Donald MacCorkyll, which was dated 1408, in "Manx Names", by A.W. Moore, during the reign of King Henry IV, known as "Henry of Bolingbroke", 1399 - 1413. Surnames became necessary when governments introduced personal taxation. In England this was known as Poll Tax. Throughout the centuries, surnames in every country have continued to "develop" often leading to astonishing variants of the original spelling.



Above map shows the English Ports of 'Liverpool' and 'Barrow in Furness' in relationship with the Isle of Man.

The main character in this journal worked his way up to become a 'Master Mariner' on the ferries which frequented the above ports and other Ports in England from the Isle of Man.

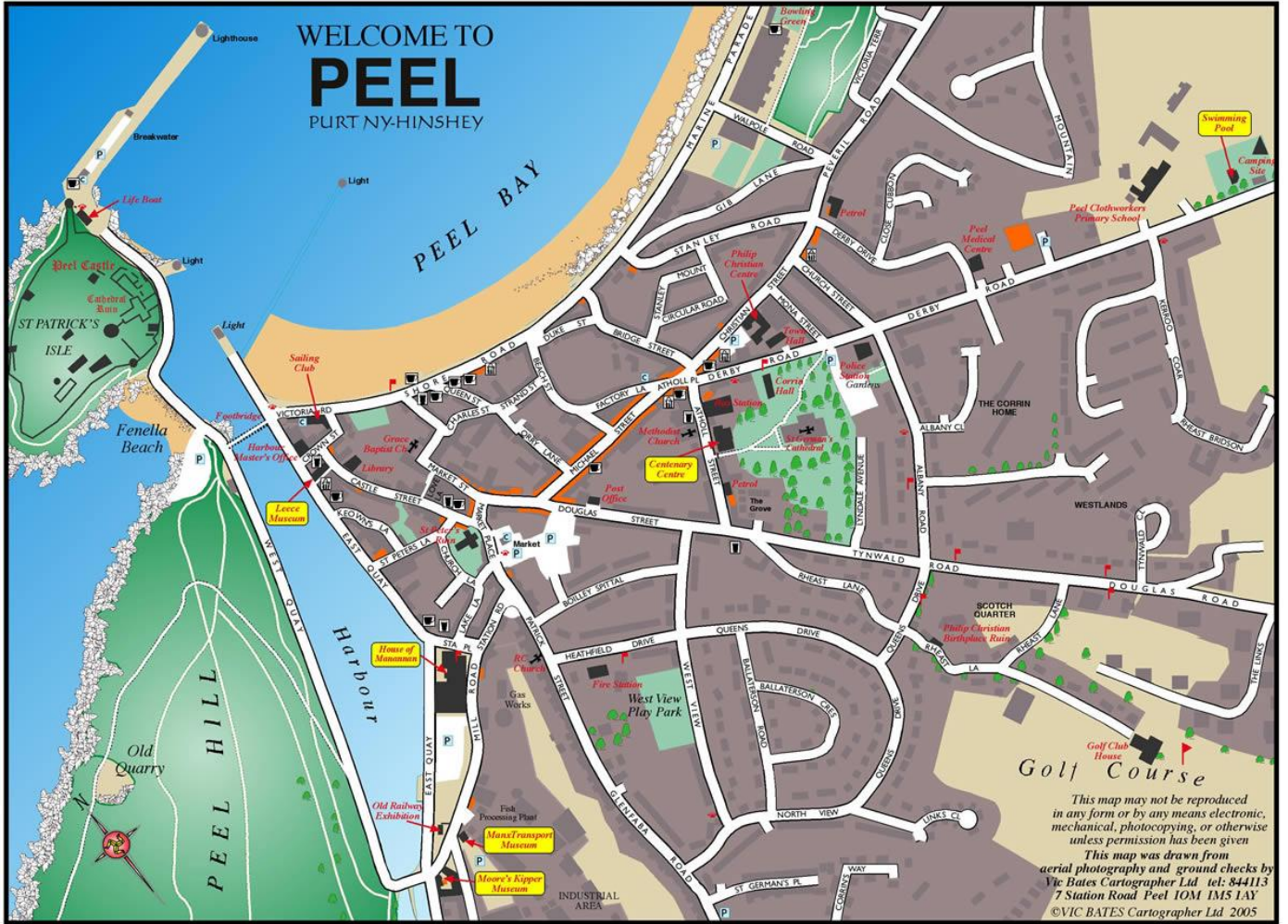


Note: Firstly, the compiler has decided to give a background into the families of Margaret Ann Quirk. With out her there would not have been the Corkill family as we know it today...

Note: Unfortunately, there are no earlier family records for Jane Hamilton before her marriage to 'Philip Quirk'. in the Isle of Man. One census record tells us she was born in Ireland.

It is possible that soon after her marriage to Philip Quick he could have been whisked away into the army. Reason being, that it wasn't until 1822-23 three to four years after they were married, that they started to have children. Then there were gaps of some years between births.

Jane remarried to John Sheard, who at the time was a Chelsea pensioner, ex-military.

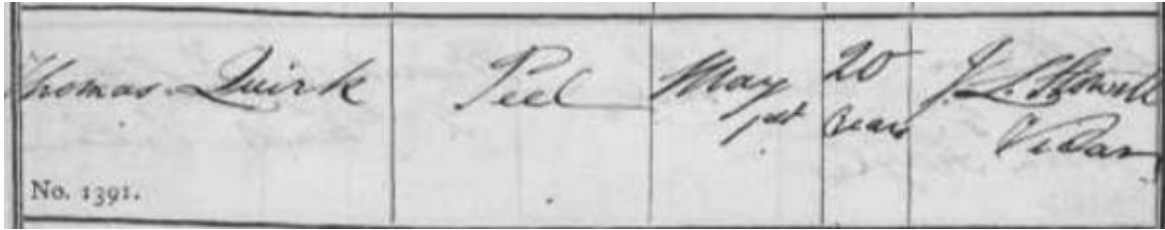

CHAPTER FOUR

OUR CORKILL FAMILY DESCENDANTS AND ANCESTORS

**Note: Following are some very early records for Ballaugh, Isle of Man, England.
Amongst them is a member of the Corkill family.**

Note on the first Parish Register of Ballaugh { Burials 1598-1678
Baptisms 1607-1690

This volume is the earliest existing Register relating to the Parish. It is, in fact, the "bound book" referred to on p. 84 of "Church Notes, Diocese of Sodor and Man" (Manx Society Publications Volume XXIX, (1879)).

This is not, of course, the original Register: after the Burials for 1678 and the Baptisms for 1690 will be found a statement dated 21st. August 1869 by the Rev. Thomas Howard (Rector 1836-76) certifying that these entries are a "true copy of an ancient book purporting to be a Register of Burials ... [and] Baptisms in the parish of Ballaugh".

The "ancient book" was apparently handed over to the Rector in a "very dilapidated state" c. 1840. The Rev. William Kenmode (Rector 1877-90) describes the "ancient book" as being "little better than pulp", and evidently in itself only a copy of the original. The original Register covering this period had apparently been lost even in 1754, in which year the Rev. Philip Moore (Rector 1751-60) submitted a "Memorial of the Register of Ballaugh" to the Vicars-General.

A full account of the Parish Registers of Ballaugh by Rev. William Kenmode can be found at pp. 277-279 of the MS volume "Parochialia Sanctae Mariae de Ballaugh", which is in the possession of the Rector.

THOMAS CORKILL THE BROTHER OF EDWARD CORKILL

Died May 26th, 1920.

We regret to record the death of Mr Thomas Corkill, which took place at his residence, 1 Hawarden-avenue, Douglas, on Wednesday, May 26th. He had been very unwell for a considerable time. Mr Corkill was a son of the late Mr Peter Corkill, who was a shoemaker, and came from Peel about 50 years ago. Capt. [Edward Corkill](#) was a brother and there were several sisters. For many years he was principal cutter with Mr T. Halsall, tailor and outfitter, of Victoria-street, and only retired when his health failed. He was a great reader, particularly of books of philosophy and sociology, and was one of the founders of the Douglas Debating Society, of which he was a member up to a few years ago. His essays were always remarkable for forcefulness and advanced thinking. In his younger days he was a leading bass singer, and gave his services freely, both on the concert and amateur dramatic stage, for many, philanthropic objects. He was a great student of Nietzsche, the German philosopher, and whom he admired. He was twice married; his second wife survives. Mr Corkill was about seventy years. The interment took place at Kirk Braddan Cemetery on 28 May 1920.

THOMAS CORKILL
THE BROTHER OF OUR EDWARD CORKILL

Died May 26th, 1920.

We regret to record the death of Mr Thomas Corkill, which took place at his residence, 1 Hawarden-avenue, Douglas, on Wednesday, May 26th. He had been very unwell for a considerable time. Mr Corkill was a son of the late Mr Peter Corkill, who was a shoemaker, and came from Peel about 50 years ago. Capt. [Edward Corkill](#) was a brother and there were several sisters. For many years he was principal cutter with Mr T. Halsall, tailor and outfitter, of Victoria-street, and only retired when his health failed. He was a great reader, particularly of books of philosophy and sociology, and was one of the founders of the Douglas Debating Society, of which he was a member up to a few years ago. His essays were always remarkable for forcefulness and advanced thinking. In his younger days he was a leading bass singer, and gave his services freely, both on the concert and amateur dramatic stage, for many, philanthropic objects. He was a great student of Nietzsche, the German philosopher, and whom he admired. He was twice married; his second wife survives. Mr Corkill was about seventy years. The interment took place at Kirk Braddan Cemetery on 28th May 1920.

A FRIEND'S APPRECIATION.

The death of Tom Corkill, after a long and painful illness, borne with heroic patience, will mean an irreparable loss to all who were his friends. Those who are left of the old brigade—and, alas I many have lost the number of their mess since the date of the late Queen Victoria's Jubilee—will echo with sincere sorrow the poet's plaint, " Oh, for the touch of a vanished hand, and the sound of a voice is still!" It is a quarter of a century since the the writer first came into personal contact with Tom Corkill, though I had listened to his magnificent voice in various ballads when he was a professional singer. It was within a few hours of my adventure to the Island in search of a home. The privilege first of his acquaintance, and afterwards of the firm friendship of such an honest thinker and sincere student, has been a source of unalloyed pleasure and no small measure of enlightenment, and a proper conception of the word of letters when non-professionally viewed. Tom Corkill was a student and a critic of original ideas. To him, as to Pope, the Laureate of Twickenham, the proper study of mankind is man.

In the early days of the Socialist movement, he was a staunch upholder of its propaganda, and a firm supporter of Robert Blatchford and the "Clarion" Fellowship, and particularly of Francis Adams, the poet and essayist. But he always rather disdained the kid-gloved faddist of the Fabian School, and had no use for the Keir Hardies, the Lansburys, the Ramsay MacDonald's, who slobber Bolshevism and would have us burn down our houses to roast a Socialist pig. He was an Empire man, a Manxman if you like, of the bulldog breed—a King's man who, faced with trouble in a foreign land, would have pinned his faith to the creed, Romanus Oiris Sum," and expected his Government to back him up as

such, as they did in the days when Palmerston was Foreign Secretary, and not 'betray him as we fear place-mongers would do at the present time.

As he reached the grand climacteric, his opinions modified and mellowed in some degree. To the end, however, his admiration of Nietzsche never entirely waned, and "Thus said Zarathustra" commenced many of the philippics which charmed all who listened to them, whether they agreed with his conclusions or not. On such abstruse subjects as Heredity, Criminology, and Psychology, he was a perfect treasure-trove of quaint information and out-of-the-way knowledge. To him, the most recondite works of such masters as Lombroso, Berahardi, Strendberg, Havelock Ellis, the great Russian and Norwegian pessimists, were not "a fountain sealed." His conversation concerning them, their outlook, and how they have affected English art of any calibre, was decorated with apt reference and appropriate quotation, for he had a phenomenal memory, and with startling criticism.

There are many men of the younger generation in Manx land who owe to him their some of the seriousness of life and their perception, even if it is dim, of the vexed problems of existence as it confronts us bit our predetermined passage from the cradle to the grave. Tom Corkill was not a voluminous writer. He had not the itch for the advertisement of the printed page, nor did he choose to court favour by public speaking. The one paper I heard him present was at the Douglas Debating Society on "Podsnaps." It was a great popular success and showed that side of his complex nature which worshipped Charles Dickens' genius, even if he revelled in Schopenhauer, Guy de Maupassant, and Oscar Wilde.

It must not, however, be supposed that Tom Corkill was either Precisian, Puritan, or Pedant. He had a Gargantuan joy of living and a Rabalaisian sense of pungent humour. "Give me," he would say, with a Homeric chuckle, "a man who knows how to drink his wine, a woman who knows how to laugh, and a raconteur who stops when his point is made." He did two of these acts very delightfully himself, and a petticoat who was facile at the other charmed him. Art, to him, was the Alpha and Omega—art in all its catholicity. Art to him was the expression of all the emotions and sensations. Art to him ranged the whole gamut of life, good and bad, ugly, and beautiful tragedy, and comedy. Art, he would say, therefore, inspires, or debases; it is as powerful for good as for bad—good when it enlarges life, bad when it narrows life. The emotions discovered for him more vasty continents than the eyes of voyagers than ever behold, and he was prodigally generous in sharing his pleasures with his friends. There was hardly a subject from Shakespeare to the musical glasses on which he had not something new and interesting to say. Manx folklore—and he was proud of his descent from one Thorkil, or boat-steerer, who came to the Island from the wild North Land two hundred years B.C. (Thorkill became corrupted into Corkill); Vachell's play of "Quinneys"; Pinero's last failure; or such fiction as "Tarzan of the Apes"—all and everything appealed to him, and he discussed them in a provocative and suggestive way, using epigram to punctuate argument, fantasy to polish phrase, and acute analytical judgment to arouse and hold the attention of even groundlings.

Yet with all his gifts, Tom Corkill was very human. He had his foibles, as all of us—even the salt of the earth are not free from them. He had two' strong fancies—he loved little children and he loathed lawyers. Both quite honourable inclinations! It was a pleasure to hear him quote Shelley on the fraternity.

*War is the statesman's game, the priest's delight,
The lawyer's jest, the hired assassin's trade.*

*These, too, the tyrant serve who skilled to share
The feet of justice in the toils of law,*

Stand ready to oppress the weaker still;

And right or wrong will vindicate for gold,

Sneering at public virtue which beneath

Their pitiless tread lies torn and trampled where

Honour sits smiling at the sale of truth.

To hear Tom Corkill, defame this and other loved passages from Shelley was to listen to a "tour de force" of elocutionary excellence and dramatic capacity. There have been occasions in our courts which would have excited his just anger, for he was proud of Manx land. of Manxmen, and Manxwomen, and anything which brought shame on them, as this has done, would have hurt him to the heart's care.

His love for children he had to indulge vicariously, for he had none of his own.

And now we shall see him no more, nor hear him speak—and we shall ever regret until we, too—

Lie at the last beneath where the grass grows,

Made one, in one interminable repose.

Not knowing whence, we came or whither went—

Manx Genealogy

IOM History, 1909

It has been suggested that certain researchers may be interested in a section of memoirs my grandfather had written, so I am pasting it on the forum. Hopefully, it will help someone.

I had been home for a few days when my brother in law, a Mr. Corkhill, dropped in to visit. He was of around sixty years of age and he was married to my oldest sister, Flo, who was the eldest of the family and about thirty five years of age. She had married Ted Corkhill who was a widower, he was the captain of one of the Isle of Man steamers which plied between Liverpool and the Isle of Man in the summer season and then laid up in the docks at Barrow for any repairs needed at the large shipyard of Vickers Moxin. There were at times as many as five or six of these boats laid up in Barrow for the winter each of them had a watchman and they nearly all used to buy their supplies at my dad's store. The Captain of these steamers used to rotate in teams to act as supervisors, as they all had their homes in the Isle of Man. Ted as we called him, had got well acquainted with my Dad and had got to the stage where he used to drop in and have a little refreshment and that was how they had got acquainted. He was due to return to the Island at this time and was to take over the duties of Harbour Master in Douglas on his return, so it was decided that I would go across with him and see my sister who had just had her first child a girl whom they christened Mona. We took the train to Liverpool and went on board one of the companies boats, The Snaefell to make the crossing. My brother in law introduced me to the Captain, a Mr. Faragher and we went down into the cabin, which was crowded with passengers. There were a lot of commercial travellers going over and they were all well acquainted with Ted who introduced me to a good many. The crossing was pretty rough and I was terribly sea sick most of the way and was very glad when we disembarked. It wasn't very far from the harbour to their home so we walked the rest of the way and landed home about six o'clock in the evening. My sister who had not seen me for about six years was very pleased to see me and we spent a very enjoyable evening before retiring about midnight.

During the night a gale blew up and the Island experienced one of the worst storms it had had for many years. After having breakfasted Ted and I left the house to go down to the company's offices when suddenly we heard some of the news boys shouting out the headlines of their papers. "Feared loss of the Ellan Vannan". This was another of the companies boats and she had left the port of Ramsay on the other side of the Island about midnight for Liverpool at daylight her masts were sticking up out of the water just where the boats entered the Mercey to go into Liverpool. Fortunately there were not many passengers as all on board were lost and the Island eased into mourning for quite some time. A young woman, who was staying with my sister, a Miss Storey, and was a stewardess on one of the boats in the busy season, had been asked to make the trip, but as she didn't need to make the money, turned the chance over to another stewardess, a widow named Callister, who was amongst the missing. I had been on the Island for several days, when Ted suggested that we take a trip out to the country to visit an old friend of theirs, who had a market garden in one of the many lovely glens for which the Isle of Man is famous. Joe Faragher happened to drop in and as he was another friend of the same party, it was decided that four of us including Miss Storey would all go on the trip. One of the first things they did was to hire a carriage and pair of horses, buy a bottle of whiskey and head for the glen which was situated about four miles from a place called Peel. I don't know how many miles it was from Douglas but it was quite a long drive.

When we reached the place, which was a type of small American bungalow we were greeted by an elderly man of about 75 years of age and a very attractive young woman, whom I was soon to learn was in her twenty first year. She had been keeping house for her uncle Robbie and his wife for about seven years, from the day that she had left school. His wife had

been blind for some years and at the time of our visit had been dead about four years. She had stayed on to keep house for the old man, used to get up early in the morning to pick strawberries and raspberries and put up bunches of flowers, which along with a variety of fresh vegetables and rhubarb the old man used to take a flat load into Peel nearly every day in the summer season. We had a very enjoyable visit and before we left for home, the young lady had a pressing invitation to come to Douglas for a visit with the Corkhill family.

My grandfather married this young lady the following February and then absconded with her to Saskatchewan....She was definitely hit by culture shock seeing her shack with the thatched roof and wild prairie greeting her. The thing that upset her the most was the fact that the train men THREW their luggage off the train, some 1/2 mile up the track. Although Grandad never mentions her name, it was Katie Greggor. I believe "Uncle Robbie" could have been Robbie Hall, but haven't been able to prove this, as yet. Grandad was Harold George Ferraby.
