**EARLY ORIGINS OF THE FERRABY FAMILY**

*The surname Ferraby was first found in Lincolnshire where John de Ferieby was listed in the Curia Regis Rolls of 1212. Later, William de Feriby was listed in Berkshire in 1301 and Wylliam Feraby was listed in the Subsidy Rolls for Suffolk in 1524.*

*South Ferriby is a parish, in the union of Glandford-Brigg, N. division of the wapentake of Yarborough, parts of Lindsey, in Lincolnshire and North Ferriby is a parish, in the county of the town of Hull, union of Sculcoates, in the East Riding of Yorkshire. "A priory of Knights Templars founded here by Lord Eustace de Vesci, of Bromfleet, was, at the suppression of that order, converted into a priory of Augustine canons. "*

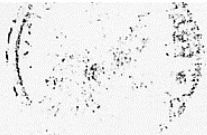

*England's Biggest Parish Church?*

*Review of Hull Minster*

*Reviewed 8 September 2015*

*The Holy Trinity Church occupies a prime spot in the middle of Hull's Old Town. Its over 700 years old and claims to be the largest parish church in the England - many of our guests are usually surprised that it's not a cathedral. It's been the focus of Hull's life for many years, William Wilberforce was baptised here, and recently it has hosted a variety of vents to "reach out" to the con-church goers. Among the most controversial has been the annual Hull CAMRA Beer festival, now an annual event that passed off with a great success.*

*The building is a Grade 1 listed building, but plans are afoot to strip out the pews and wooden interior (on the pretext they are only 200 years or so old!) and create a big meeting space with a cafe. There is furore among the more traditional Christians, but the local Council seem adamant that this 'modernisation' goes ahead so they have somewhere for big events for the City of Culture, which Hull is staging in 2017. For now, though the church is simply magnificent and awe-inspiring in its ancient beauty and history. Many memorials to Hull's seafaring past can be found in the church, including ships' bells from the Gaul, a famous trawler lost with all hands in the 70s, and the Norland, a local ferry which took thousands of troops to the Falklands War. If you want to see some real history before the council vandals consign much of the interior to a skip, I'd advise a visit as soon as possible. It's well worth an hour of your time, I'm sure you will return for more. The volunteers are a mine of information and very welcoming – it's well worth arriving when there are services on as their choir sounds excellent in this lovely building.*

*HULL, or Kingston-Upon-Hull, a seaport, borough, and county of itself, situated on the borders of the East Riding of York, 39 miles SE from York, and 170 N from London: comprising the **parishes of St. Mary, the Holy Trinity, Drypool, and Sculcoates, the extra-parochial district of Garrison-Side, and part of the parish of Sutton. The Trinity House** was built in 1457 and rebuilt in 1753. The **Charterhouse** was founded in the year 1384.*

*Holy Trinity is an ancient and spacious cruciform structure, with a lofty and very beautiful tower rising from the intersection and supported on piers and arches of elegant proportions: the east end is in the decorated English style, and the transepts are fine specimens of the earliest period of that style; the window in the south transept is filled with tracery and enriched with mouldings of curious character. The edifice was re-opened, after judicious restoration, in December 1845.*

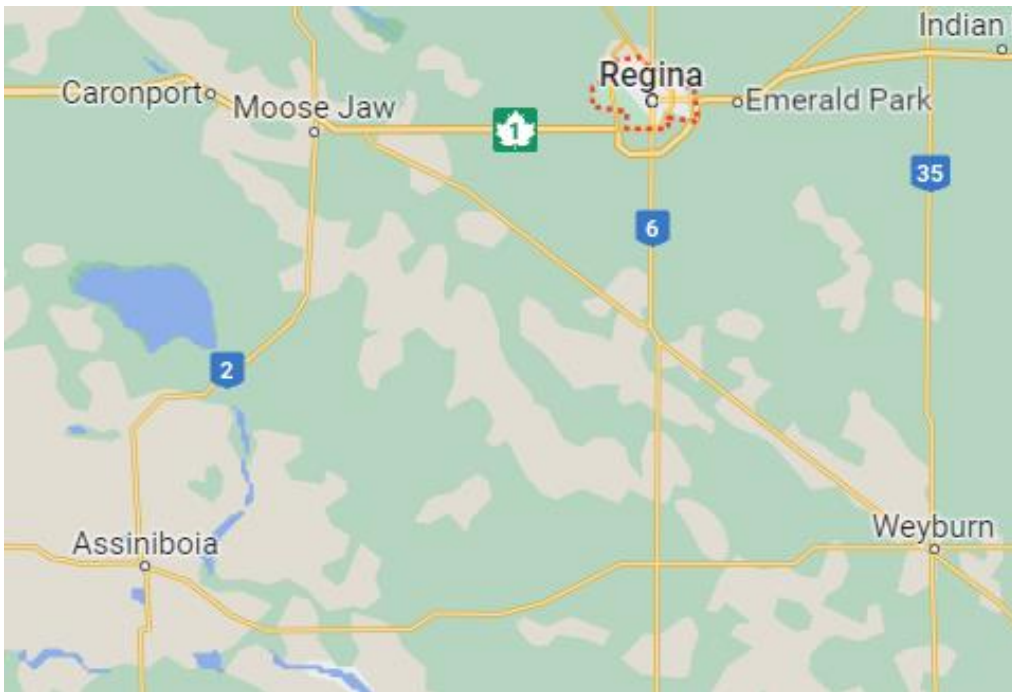

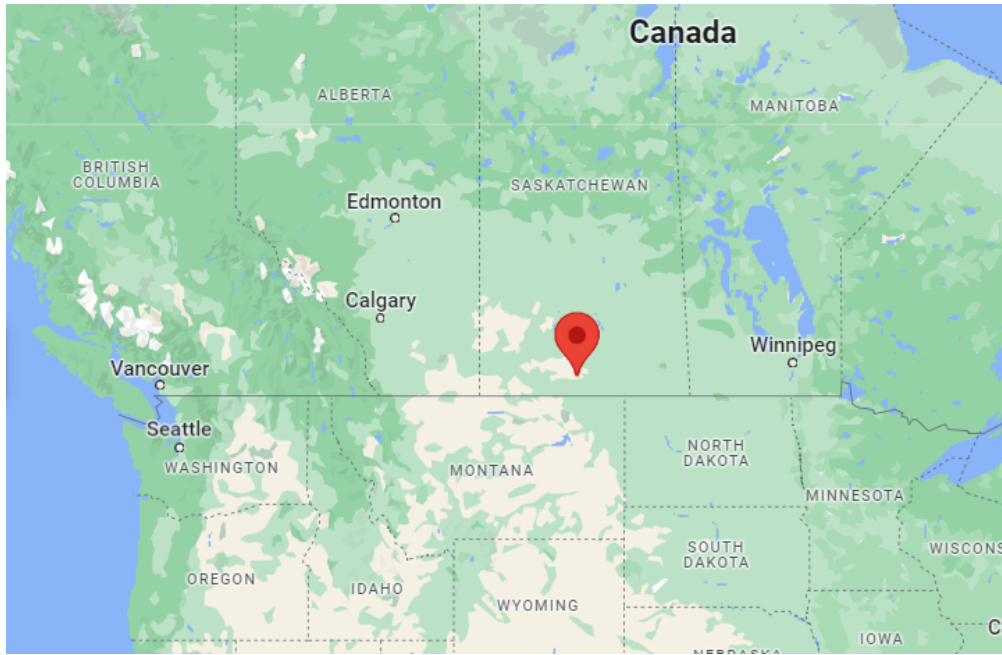

*The Rural Municipality of 'Lake of The Rivers No. 72' was established in 1911. The RM was named after the body of water located in the centre of the municipality- 'Lake of The Rivers'. The RM encompasses approximately 165,000 acres of land and surrounds the Town of Assiniboia. The main highways located in the RM are highway #2 and highway #13 east. In the 2021 census Statistics Canada confirmed the population to be 252 which was a slight decrease from the prior census at 279.*

*The RM is an agriculturally based economy with both cultivated land and cattle ranching being the primary use of land. Paterson Grain Elevator, South Country Equipment, Wilcock Mobile Service, Integra Tire, Dave Mihalicz Excavating Ltd., Delorme Seeds Ltd. and West Side Storage are some of the main businesses operating in the RM boundaries. In 2020 Golden South Wind LLP developed a wind farm on the southwestern portion of the RM. The Golden South Wind Project consists of 50 turbines, with 46 of those turbines being in the RM boundaries.*



*The Assiniboia Regional Park Golf Course located just south of the Town of Assiniboia provides beautifully maintained greens for golfers to enjoy during the summer months. The Willows Reservoir located 11 km's southeast of Assiniboia along Highway 13 east, is a popular place to fish both perch and pickerel year-round. The main hub of recreation for residents lies within the Town of Assiniboia which provide a wide range of facilities and programs.*

*Two churches can be found in the RM – Emmanuel Prairie Garden Lutheran Church & Davy Royd United Church. Furthermore, the Town of Assiniboia's public airport is located in the northwest portion of the RM just off highway #2 north- this facility is used mainly for agricultural aerial spraying. The RM has no active hamlets or villages located in its boundaries.*

## CHAPTER NINE

### FERRABY HISTORY AND OTHER...

From Drake's History and Antiquities of York, Page 205.

John Ferriby, the Lord Mayor answered (to Edward IV, then fighting the "Red Rose" party) most noble Duke, for other style you seem not to require, or if you should, can we acknowledge; we are very sensible what bloody conflicts have been for the Crown, which hath been the Bale of Contention between the Red Rose and the White: I name the Red Rose first because that is in the present possession, and if you, Sir Duke, would set on foot the claim of the White Rose, we know not what mischief might follow; sure we are, if we admit you, we should be blamed by King Henry and by that make--King the Earl of Warwick, whom you mention: Therefore in few words this is our Resolution, that unless you will swear not to make any pretention to the crown nor disturb the King in the Government, and not to prejudice the Rights and Privileges of this City, we will not admit you into this City.

Eventually the Mayor and Corporation allowed him to enter. He borrowed a considerable sum of money from them. He assumed the title of King. He placed a garrison in the city and then marched south, fought battle at Barnet, killed Warwick, and sent Henry again to the Tower. He then reigned in peace and died 1483, having paid back the money he had borrowed from the City of York. He apparently liked the City and often visited it to the end of his life.

During the 16th and 17th centuries no references have been discovered. The family may have been affected by the Reformation, churches were robbed of records, many being sent to Rome and many destroyed. Probably also, the family declined in wealth and importance. They still held considerable land outside Hull and I can remember my father receiving cheques from some of his land which was sold gradually for building purposes from 1860 onwards for years, but none is now in the family. From 1720 records of our family have been correctly kept to present generation.

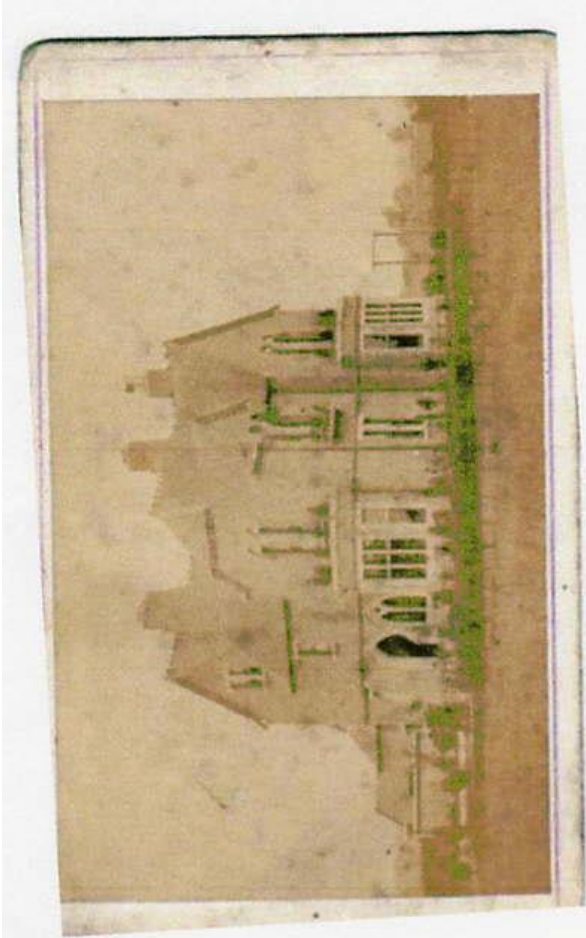

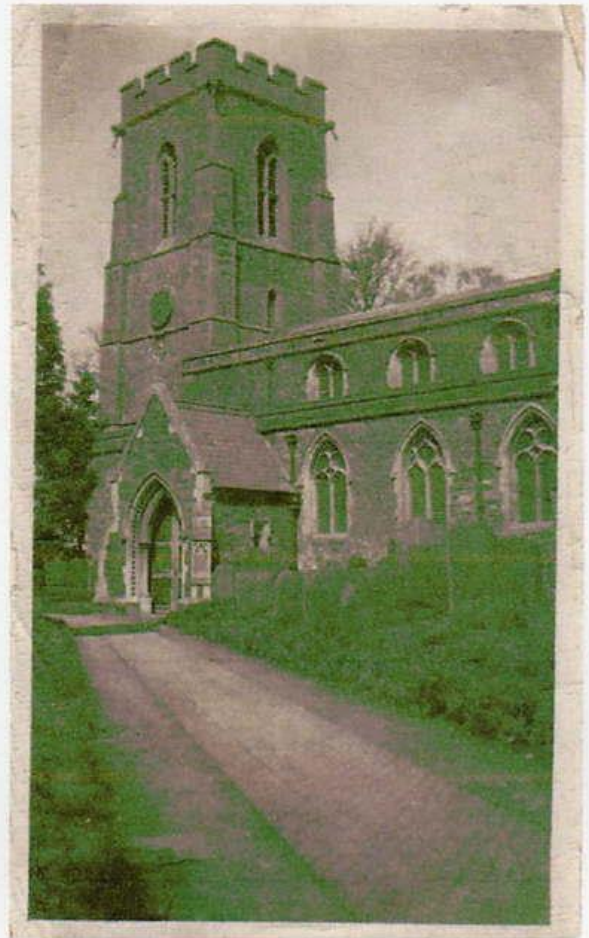

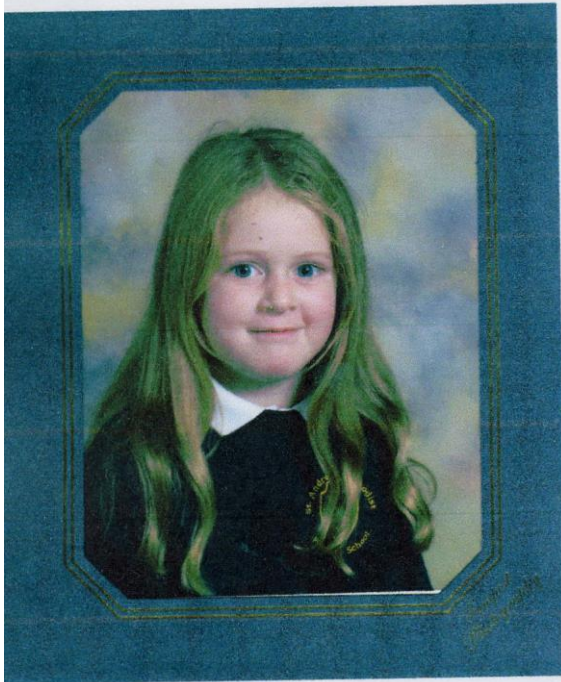
